

Pennsylvania COVID -19 Guidelines

Social Restrictions/ Gatherings:

- Indoor events can operate at a maximum of 15% capacity, regardless of venue size.
- Attendees and workers have to be 6 feet apart.
- Outdoor events can operate at a maximum of 20% capacity, regardless of venue size.
- Face coverings are required for both indoor and outdoor events.
- All venues must require social distancing and face coverings.
- Staggered arrival times, multiple entry/exit points, multiple bathrooms and hand sanitizer stations should be put in place.
- Event host must keep a list of attendees with their name and phone number and their expected location 14 days after the event.
- This info is critical for contact tracing

Starting April 4:

- Indoor events can have a max of 25% capacity, regardless of venue size.
- Outdoor events can have a max of 50% capacity, regardless of venue size.
- Must continue to wear masks and maintain social distancing guidelines.

As PA continues to open up, check with local authorities and event venues about their testing regulations.

Social Restrictions:

- 25% of maximum occupancy indoors, regardless of venue size
- 50% of maximum occupancy outdoors, regardless of venue size
