

# Vaccine Guidelines

## Vaccine Guidelines:

- People are considered fully vaccinated at least 2 weeks after your second dose of Pfizer or Moderna.
- If you got Johnson and Johnson, at least 2 weeks after a single dose.

## Fully vaccinated people can:

- Visit other fully vaccinated people indoors without masks or physical distancing
- Visit unvaccinated people who are from a single household and are low risk, without masks or social distancing.
- Participate in outdoor activities without a mask (unless in a crowded setting)
- Resume domestic travel without having to be tested before or after and do not have to self-quarantine.
- Do not have to be tested before traveling out of the country unless destination is required, no self quarantine when returning to the United States.
- Do not have to get tested if exposed to an asymptomatic person,
- Do not have to quarantine if exposed to an asymptomatic person.

## Fully vaccinated people should continue to:

- Take precautions when indoor public settings (wear a mask)
- Wear a mask when visiting indoors with unvaccinated people who are high risk.
- Wear a mask when visiting indoors with unvaccinated people from multiple households.
- Avoid large indoor gatherings.
