New Jersey COVID -19 Guidelines

Gatherings

- There are no numerical limits for indoor or outdoor gatherings
- You should wear a mask and social distance if you are not vaccinated
- New Jersey will no longer require restaurants, retail stores, gyms, churches, and other businesses to keep 6 feet of social distance
- Businesses can still choose to require social distancing and masks.

Safety Tips:

- Keep a guest list to see who attended for contact tracing.

Effective June 4th:

- End all indoor gathering limits on June 4 for political activities, wedding ceremonies and receptions, funerals, memorial services, performances, catered events, and commercial gatherings.
- Has ended its current 30% capacity limit for large indoor venues with fixed seating of 1,000 or greater.
- Full crowds, with no social distancing, at indoor concerts and
